

## ORDINANCE NO. 2020-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF GREENCASTLE, FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 190, ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC", OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF GREENCASTLE

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Greencastle is duly empowered by the Borough Code to enact certain regulations relating to the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Borough of Greencastle; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Greencastle is duly empowered by the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code and the Borough Code to enact certain regulations concerning the movement of vehicles and traffic within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Greencastle previously established certain stop intersections throughout the Borough by the enactment of Section 190-13 of the Borough Code; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Greencastle desires to amend Chapter 190, Section 190-13 of the Borough Code to provide for a new stop intersection at the intersection of Elm Lane and West Spruce Lane.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Greencastle, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, and it is enacted and ordained as follows:

**SECTION 1**: Chapter 190 of the Code of the Borough of Greencastle, entitled "Vehicles and Traffic", Section 13 thereof, entitled "Stop Intersections", Subsection A is hereby amended to add the following:

Stop Street Elm Lane	Through Street West Spruce Lane	<b>Direction of Travel</b> South

**SECTION 2**: Repealer. All provisions of previous ordinances of the Borough of Greencastle, or parts thereof, which are contrary or inconsistent to this Ordinance, are expressly repealed.

**SECTION 3**: Savings Clause. In all other respects, Chapter 190 of the Code of the Borough of Greencastle shall remain as previously enacted and ordained.

**SECTION 4**: Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and if any of its sections, clauses or sentences shall be held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional, such provision shall not affect or impair any remaining sections, clauses or sentences of the same.

SECTION 5: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
