## Ordinance 2007-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE AND ZONING MAP OF THE BOROUGH OF GREENCASTLE, FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA. CHANGING THE DESIGNATION FOR THE AREA BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY WEST FRANKLIN STREET EXTENDED, ON THE SOUTH BY NOVA DRIVE, ON THE EAST BY THE REAR OF PROPERTIES APPROXIMATELY 250 FEET WEST OF SOUTH ANTRIM WAY, AND ON THE WEST BY THE REAR OF PROPERTIES FACING WAY WESTERN **JAMES** OR THE BOROUGH LINE, GREENCASTLE, PENNSYLVANIA FROM (I) INDUSTRIAL TO (HC) HIGHWAY COMMERCIAL

Be it enacted and ordained by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Greencastle, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same:-

SECTION 1. The zone designation for the area bounded on the north by West Franklin Street Extended, on the south by Nova Drive, on the east by the rear of properties approximately 250 feet west of South Antrim Way, and on the west by the rear of properties facing James Way or the western Borough Line, Greencastle, Pennsylvania, as more fully depicted in the area highlighted in the exhibit attached hereto and made part hereof, being the Zoning Map of the Borough of Greencastle, is hereby changed from (I) Industrial to (HC) Highway Commercial.

SECTION 2. The zoning map of the Borough of Greencastle, Franklin County, Pennsylvania is hereby amended to reflect the changes in the zoning districts described in Section 1. above.

SECTION 3. The remaining provisions of the Zoning Ordinance and Zoning Map of the Borough of Greencastle, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, not amended hereby, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. Upon enactment by the Borough Council, this amendment to the Zoning Ordinance and Zoning Map shall become effective as provided by law.

removal, refuse collection, tree trimming, and any other type of municipal or utility function.

- 7. The use of sirens by any authorized emergency vehicle that is responding to an emergency or acting in any other official capacity.
- 8. Emergency work. Work performed for the purpose of preventing or repairing the physical trauma or property damage.
- 9. Any train or aircraft being operated pursuant to Commonwealth or Federal regulations.

## **SECTION IV:** Administration

The Greencastle Police Department shall have the authority to administer the provisions of this ordinance and to investigate complaints and prosecute violations of this chapter.

## SECTION V: Enforcement and Penalties

Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) and no more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00), and cost of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fines and costs, to imprisonment of not more than ten (10) days. Each day a violation occurs or continues shall be considered a separate offense.

<u>SECTION VI</u>: Repealer. All provisions of previous Ordinances of the Borough of Greencastle which are contrary to this Ordinance are expressly repealed.

SECTION VII: Severability. If any sentence, clause, paragraph, section or portion of this chapter is declared by any court of competent jurisdiction to be illegal, invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION VIII: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
