ORDINANCE NO. 2006-07

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF GREENCASTLE, FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING OFFICIAL ZONING MAP OF THE BOROUGH OF GREENCASTLE AS PROVIDED IN ORDINANCE NO205 BY CHANGING THE ZONING OF 300 SOUTH CARLISLE STREET FROM INDUSTRIAL (I) TO GENERAL RESIDENTIAL (R-2).

SECTION I: Be enacted and ordained by the Borough Council of the Borough of Greencastle, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that the official zoning map of the Borough of Greencastle as provided for in Ordinance No. 205 is amended to rezone the property located at 300 South Carlisle Street from Industrial (I) to General Residential (R-2).

SECTION II: The official zoning map shall be changed to reflect the change in zoning as set forth in Section I without delay and an entry in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 205 shall be made on the official map and signed by the President of the Borough Council and attested by the Borough Secretary. The change shall not become effective until it has been duly entered upon the Official Zoning Map.

SECTION III: If any section, clause or part of Ordinance No. 205 as amended is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 205 by amending the official zoning map shall become effective upon adoption; said official zoning map having been changed and the entry duly noted thereon on November 6, 2006.
